



Abstract of the Foundation Charter of the Robert-Karl Rudolph Youth Trust

(*) The object of the trust is to support and encourage education, as well as helping young people. Teenagers should be supported and encouraged to use their strengths and abilities for their mental development, education and to secure their existence as well as helping others.

(*) The objectives of the trust will be achieved specifically by the active and financial support of youth work in facilities promoting Christian ideas and the principal of a free society.

- (*) The following sanctions are proposed for the trusts' work:
- Financing youth workers, for example youth workers taking a gap year in the social sector
 - Educational support for young people in the commercial, educational and university sectors.
 - Leisure activities through which teenagers are supported culturally, intellectually and socially.
 - Supporting ideas created by teenagers own initiatives and other activities in social areas; arranging informative events.

(*) The members of the Committee and the Board of Trustees are working on a voluntary basis.

(*) No person shall be allowed to take any advantage through inadequate payments or through expenses born by the foundation, which are not appropriate to the objectives of the foundation.



VL (Viele Leute - many people) was the sign of Robert's large circle of friends. They used to make music together, had parties and were there for one another. Today they are active members of the ROBERT-KARL RUDOLPH YOUTH TRUST.

The accidental death of the only 25 years old Robert-Karl Rudolph was a big loss not only for his friends and family. At the end of his youth he had made the foundations for his future happiness and success.

He was not able to continue.

The Robert-Karl Rudolph Youth Trust aims to help prepare the path to happiness, health and success - also for those teenagers who are losing their way in life and are going to be a loss to society. They will be supported and encouraged to use their strengths and abilities for their personal development, education and in securing their existence in a self-supporting way as well as helping others.

The Youth Trust does not want to carry out its work for social reasons alone, but believes it is also very important in an economic sense; an investment into the future which will shape these young people - according to their strength and abilities.
